### DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From campus take U.S. Route 1 north 1 mile. Enter I-95/Capital Beltway north toward Baltimore. At the split, stay on I-95 North. Proceed for approximately 15 miles and exit onto I-195 East to BWI.

### METROBUS/RAIL DIRECTIONS

- BWI is accessible from Union Station (Red Line) and New Carrollton Station (Orange Line) Metro Stops, where you can pick up the MARC Train Penn Line to BWI. The New Carrollton Station is also accessible by the F6 Metro bus which runs along Campus Drive.
- The B30 bus runs from Greenbelt Metro Station to BWI every 40 minutes from 6am-10pm. The fare is \$3.

### DRIVING DIRECTIONS

- From the traffic light on US Rt.1, adjacent to the UM Visitor Center, head South for about 2.3 miles and bear left onto Alternate US Rt. 1.
- Follow the Alternate US Rt.1 for about 3.1 miles and turn right onto New York Ave (US Rt.50). Continue for about 2.5 miles and turn left onto I-395 South, following the signs to Northern VA.
- Just after crossing the Potomac River, exit I-395 onto the George Washington Parkway (south). Within one mile, follow the signs to the desired airline or facility at Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport.

- The National Airport stop is accessible by the Blue or Yellow lines on Metro.

### DRIVING DIRECTIONS

- From the traffic light on US Rt.1 and Campus Drive (Main Entrance), head North for 2.2 miles, cross over I-95 and exit onto I-95 North.
- Keep left to stay on I-495/Capital Beltway West to Silver Spring.
- Exit 45A onto the Dulles Toll Road and follow signs to the airport (approximately 13 miles from the exit).

### METROBUS/RAIL DIRECTIONS

Metrobus 5A runs from downtown D.C.—L'Enfant Plaza (Green/Yellow Line) & Rosslyn (Blue/Orange Line) to Dulles Airport and along the Dulles corridor hourly between 5am-12am. The fare is \$3.
